**INSTRUMENT OF AUTHORISATION FOR
THE TRANSMISSION OF SUBSEQUENT
DECLARATIONS MADE PURSUANT TO
THE CONVENTION ON INTERNATIONAL
INTERESTS IN MOBILE EQUIPMENT AND
THE AIRCRAFT PROTOCOL**

Whereas the Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment was adopted in Cape Town on the 16th of November, 2001.

And Whereas it is provided in Article 57 of the aforesaid Convention that a State Party may make a subsequent declaration, other than a declaration authorized under Article 60, at any time after the date on which this Convention has entered into force for it, by notifying the Depository to that effect.

Now Therefore, I, OLUSEGUN OBASANJO, President of the Federal Republic of Nigeria on behalf of the Government of the Federal Republic of Nigeria do hereby authorize the transmission to the International Institute for the Unification of Private Law (UNIDROIT) of the attached Declarations (Subsequent Declarations) made pursuant to the Convention on International Interests in Mobile Equipment and Article XXXIII of the Protocol Specific to Aircraft Equipment.
